

# Homestay

Comfortable accommodation plays an important part when going abroad to study a foreign language and we will always make an effort to make you feel at ease, secure and at home.



## General Information

- All accommodation is arranged from Saturday before the course begins until Saturday morning after the course ends.
- Should it be impossible for the student to arrange arrival and departure times in accordance with these days, extra nights can usually be arranged on payment of an additional charge (special arrangements are not possible during the high season from July to August).
- To ensure availability, please book rooms in shared apartments well in advance.
- Every effort will be made to arrange accommodation as requested. However, this can not be guaranteed in the case of late bookings. Especially for accommodation from July to September ensure early booking.
- Accommodation cannot be arranged without booking a course.

\*Please note that there is a security deposit of 100 Euros on arrival that will be refunded on departure as long as the room is left in the condition that it is found in.

To stay with a local Spanish speaking family offers a great opportunity to experience Spanish life and culture. You'll speak Spanish all day long – because there's no way around it and out of fun and interest in the family life that's unfolding around you.
